# Historical background

The Weed Science Society of the Republic of China (WSSROC, Taiwan) was founded in 1980 by Dr. Yu-Lin Chan, the dean of Department of Agricultural Chemistry, National Taiwan University. In the 80' the development of herbicides was blooming and herbicides played an important role in the agriculture of Taiwan. The Society was established to encourage the domestic and international participators to promote the development of weed science.

# Objective / mandate

- 1. To promote the research of weed and its control.
- 2. To hold conferences and seminars of weed science.
- 3. To pool the domestic and international book reference of weed science for research, education and agricultural study.
- 4. To publish the scientific journals.

- 6. To manage other activities related to weed science.
